


Installing your risers —



Starting at the top step, measure the height and width of the riser.





Using a miter and table saw, cut the riser to the necessary measurements.

Dry fit to ensure a snug fit. (Do NOT force into place).


Using urethane based construction adhesive, apply a generous "intermittent" bead around the perimeter of the riser and then throughout the middle in a serpentine pattern.

Carefully slide your riser into place so it is flush. Push firmly on the riser. (Immediately remove any excess adhesive).

Note: When installing risers on an open-end step, it will be necessary to use a piece of molding to cover the exposed Edge.

REPEAT THE PROCESS FOR EACH STEP.
